ARTICLE EIGHT

Every owner of a lot which is subject to assessment shall be a member of the Corporation. Membership shall be appurtenant to and may not be separated from ownership of any lot which is subject to assessment. The Corporation shall have two classes of voting membership:

Class A: Class A members shall be all owners with the exception of MacNaughton & Co., Trustee, Agent and Attorney in Fact for Coronado Motor Hotels, Inc. entitled to one vote for each lot owned. When more than one person holds an interest in any lot, all such persons shall be members. The vote of such lot shall be exercised as they smong themselves determine, but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to a lot.

Class B: Class B members shall be MacNaughton & Co.,
Agent and Attorney in Fact for Coronado Motor Hotels, Inc.
or its successors and assigns if such successors or
assigns should acquire more than one undeveloped lot

development. Class B members shall be entitled to
three votes for each lot owned. The Class B membership
shall cease and be converted to Class A membership on the
happening of either of the following events, whichever
occurs earlier: (1) When the total votes outstanding
in Class B membership including duly annexed areas, but
subject to further cessation in accordance with the
limitations set forth in this paragraph: or (2) on
January 1 of 1980.
