

West Airport Homeowners Association TREE PLANTING GUIDELINES

The Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions for the West Airport Homeowners Association sections one, two, and six require two trees between the front of the residence and the curb. In order to account for the variation of home and lot configurations throughout the community, the West Airport Homeowners Association has established the following guidelines concerning trees in front of residences.

TYPE OF TREES

Trees recommended for the Houston area are shown on the next page. All are acceptable for planting within the community under these guidelines.

SIZE OF TREES

Trees shall have a minimum diameter of two inches at a height of twelve inches above ground level. All trees shall be a minimum of six feet tall when planted.

PLACEMENT

A minimum of two trees shall be located in the area between the front of the residence and the curb line of the street fronting the property. If there is a privacy wall in front of the residence, the trees must be planted in front of the wall. It is recommended that trees be located no closer than ten feet from foundations or driveways and a minimum of twenty feet from adjacent trees.

If a residential lot does not allow for the specified placement of trees, the following may be substituted for <u>one</u> of the trees:

- * Crepe myrtle, waxleaf ligustrum or red tip photinia in tree form
- * Palm tree or other similar trees or shrubbery approved in advance

Any tree substitutions must be pruned in "tree form" meaning the trunks are clean at the bottom and all leaves and foliage are at the top. Pruning is done to maximize vertical growth.

MAINTENANCE

The homeowner or occupant is responsible for maintaining the health of their trees. This includes watering, fertilizing, pruning, removing suckers, removing deadwood, staking fallen or crooked trees, and performing any other procedures to ensure the trees remain healthy and viable. Any dead trees shall be promptly removed to below ground level and replaced with ones meeting the type and size guidelines above.

VARIANCES

The Architectural Control Committee, at the direction of the Board of Directors, shall have the right to grant variances to these Guidelines on a case by case basis where the Committee in good faith deems that such variance does not adversely affect the architectural and environmental integrity of the community.
